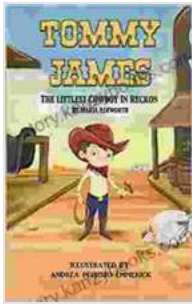


Cowboy Story On Wrangling In Bully

If you follow these tips, you will be able to wrangle in bully beef safely and efficiently.



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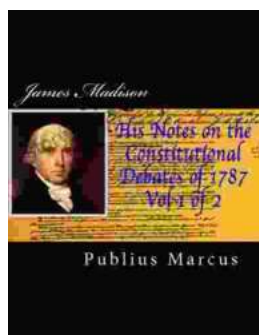
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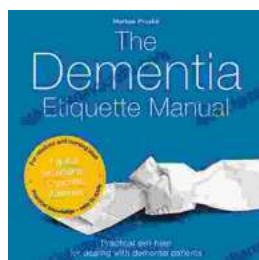
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
