
The Little Leprechaun Who Loved Yellow

Patrick didn't understand why the other leprechauns were so mean to him. He just wanted to be friends. He tried to ignore them, but it was hard. The teasing was relentless.



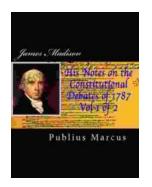
Patrick was finally accepted for who he was. He made new friends who didn't care that he was different. He was happy to be himself.

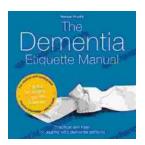
